**Boarding Pricing and Fees

- o PPTL prefers CASH, but also accepts CashApp and Venmo.
- \$35 per night to board 1 dog
- \$60 per night to board 2 dogs in same kennel (If multiple dogs are boarded in the same kennel, and require different foods or separate feedings, there will be an additional \$10 per night charge.) Dogs must fit comfortably in order to stay together.
- Fees to administer any medicines, supplements, and ointments can be discussed based on your dog's needs. (This includes, but is not limited to: vitamins, fish oils, ear ointment, topical ointment....) This is due to the time and extra responsibility we take in caring for your pet.
- o If your pet has to be transferred to the vet there is a \$25 transportation fee.
- **Deposit** Boarding requires a 50% non-refundable deposit for all stays, in order to reserve a kennel. Balance is due on the initial day of boarding. We will not hold your kennel without a deposit.
- All boarding fees need to be paid in FULL on the initial day of boarding. *Any additional fees incurred
 during the time of boarding (flea/tick treatments (such as Capstar tablets), providing for females that
 may come in heat during boarding, and veterinary costs) will be charged as needed and at the price it
 costs us plus a service fee, and will be paid to PPTL on the day of pickup. NO PETS WILL BE
 DISCHARGED UNTIL ALL CHARGES ARE PAID IN FULL.
- o Payment Deposits and Holiday fees are non-refundable.
- Holiday Fee- A flat rate of \$30 will be added for all dogs if dropping off or picking up on the following dates (holidays). Holiday fees will be capped at \$50 per kennel per day. ALSO, the following dates will have limited drop off and pickup times.
 - Wednesday December 31, 2025 (New Year's Eve)
 - Thursday January 1, 2026 (New Year's Day)
 - Friday April 3rd, 2026 (Good Friday)
 - Saturday, April 4th, 2026 (Easter Saturday)
 - Sunday April 5th, 2026 (Easter Sunday we will not accept drop-offs or pickups)
 - Monday April 6th, 2026 (Easter Monday)
 - Saturday May 23rd, 2026 (Memorial Weekend)
 - Sunday May 24th, 2026 (Memorial Weekend)
 - Monday May 25th, 2026 (Memorial Day)
 - Friday July 3, 2026 (July 4th weekend)
 - Saturday July 4, 2026 (4th of July)
 - Sunday July 5, 2026 (4th of July weekend)
 - Saturday September 5, 2026 (Labor Day weekend)
 - Sunday September 6, 2026 (Labor Day weekend)
 - Monday September 7, 2026 (Labor Day)
 - Wednesday November 25, 2026 (Thanksgiving)
 - Thursday November 26, 2026 (Thanksgiving we will not accept drop-offs or pickups)
 - Friday November 27, 2027 (Thanksgiving)
 - Wednesday December 23, 2026 (Christmas)
 - o Thursday December 24, 2026 (Christmas Eve)
 - Friday December 25, 2026 (Christmas Day we will not accept drop-offs or pickups)
 - Thursday December 31, 2026 (New Year's Eve)
 - Friday January 1, 2027 (New Year's Day)
- o PPTL will not accept drop offs or pickups on Christmas Day.
- NO SHOWS will lose all deposits, and future reservations will need to be paid for in full at the time of booking.
- We do not give refunds for early pickups.

**Drop Off and Pickup Times:

- No drop offs on Sundays.
- Sunday Pick up time will be between 4pm and 5pm January 1 March 1st, 2026 and November 1-December 31, 2026, and between 5pm and 6pm on Sundays March 8th -October 25th (daylight savings time)
- O Drop off and Pick up times for boarders is between 8-10 am and 4-5pm Monday- Saturday and Sunday as listed above. A \$50 late fee will be charged for late pickups, and your dog still needs to be picked up that day. Late pickups can result in your dog not having a kennel to stay in and this is not safe. Please book an extra night or arrange for someone to pick your dog up on time if you will not be back in time to pick up your dog on time.
- o IF these time will not work for you, please ask to make special arrangements with us AHEAD of time.
- Please send a text when you are on your way to drop off or pick up (15- 20 minutes out is good).

**Other Rules, Regulations and Notes

- We will NOT accept dogs who show signs of aggression towards people or are destructive to our kennels.
- o If your dog destroys a doggy door so that it is not usable, you will need to pay a \$50 fee to replace it. If your dog is a chewer, please send something for them to chew on.
- You are welcome to bring your dog's treats, toys, and bed/blanket. We are not responsible for lost, left, or destroyed possessions during your dogs' stay.
- o PPTL agrees to provide a safe, sanitary, and enclosed kennel for your dog(s). Your dog(s) will be fed as you instruct and handled with proper care throughout his/her stay. All persons who assist with the care of your pet are animal lovers and will show them nothing but love and lots of attention.
- Emergency Medical Care: If, in our judgment, your dog requires immediate medical care and we are unable to reach you, we will take your dog to a veterinarian or animal hospital.
- Your vet will be contacted if your pet becomes ill during his/her stay, or if there are any questions about his/her medication. However, we reserve the right to use another veterinary service in the area if your veterinarian is not available. If your pet has to be transferred to the vet there is a \$25 transportation fee. We will also stay with your pet unless the vet instructs otherwise.

In consideration for your dog(s) boarding at Porter's Puppy Tail Lodge (referred to by PPTL), you agree to all of the policies, procedures, costs, and any and all terms and conditions as set forth below. This agreement shall be in force from the date signed and shall apply to each pet and for all visits thereafter.

Please INITIAL beside each of the following. I agree to be solely responsible for the payment of all medical bills for your dog and I release PPTL, its officers, directors, agents, volunteers, and employees of and from any and all responsibility for, or claims, damages, debts, arising out of or related to such medical care, including, but not limited to, transportation to/from the veterinary clinic and choice of veterinarian and animal hospital. I understand my dogs must be healthy, and current on all vaccinations at each time of stay. I have/ and will provide (as updated) a copy of my dog's updated vaccination records from my vet. I understand that all pets are required to be vaccinated, however it is still possible for a pet to become ill even if vaccinated. If my pet(s) becomes ill, any medical expenses will be my responsibility, and I release PPTL of any charges. _ I will not bring my dog if he/she is exhibiting any symptoms that may suggest illness such as sneezing, coughing, wheezing, runny eyes or nose, vomiting, lethargy, or diarrhea. I will routinely treat my dog for fleas and ticks, and understand that my dog will be treated at my expense if fleas or ticks are found on my dog while being boarded. I acknowledge and understand that there are certain risks involved in boarding, including but not limited to dog fights, dog bites to humans or other dogs, and the transmission of disease. Any medical expenses will be my responsibility, and I release PPTL of any charges. If my dog becomes ill, I, the owner (and then emergency contact if necessary) shall be notified at once, if possible, or such attempt shall be made to so notify me, and if I do not immediately inform the kennel regarding measures to be taken or if the state of the animal's health requires quick action, the right to call a veterinarian or to administer medicine or to give advisable attention within the discretion shall be taken for granted by Porter's Puppy Tail Lodge, and I will promptly pay such expenses being reasonable in amount. _ I will bring my dog's food from home for each stay, and it will be in a container with a screw on or snap on lid. _____ I understand pickup policies and all fees. I understand that all pets are boarded, handled, and cared for by PPTL without liability in cases of death, loss, or damage from disease, theft, fire, injury, or any other unavoidable causes, while due diligence and care are exercised by PPTL. PPTL is also released of any responsibility if my dog climbs or jumps the perimeter fence. I agree that any decision made to provide for the welfare of my dog(s) during boarding will be my (the owner's) financial responsibility. Reasonable effort will be made to contact me first, followed by my emergency contact(s), prior to any treatment. Examples: flea/tick treatments (such as Capstar tablets), providing for females that may come in heat during boarding, and veterinary costs.



FAQs/FYIs

- Do I bring my dog's food?
 - YES! Your dog should continue to eat the food he/she is used to at home, so please bring your dog's food (enough for his/ her stay). It should be brought in a container with snap or screw on lid. This will help prevent spills, as well as ants and rodents from getting into opened food. This doesn't include individually packaged food or cans.
- What should I NOT to bring?
 - Anything that can present a choking hazard
 - Small or inappropriately sized toys for your dog
 - Bowls-*exception is slow feeder bowls
 - BAGS of dog food (even the re-sealable bags)
 - Several blankets (only one per dog)
- What should I bring?
 - o Your dog's vaccination record
 - o Food in a container with snap or screw on lid with his/her name on it.
 - o Something safe for your dog to chew on.
 - Any needed medications
 - One blanket per dog if you like
 - o Diapers for incontinence or heat cycle if needed
 - Puppy pads if your dog is accustomed to using them
 - Toys
 - o Treats
 - o ALL items should be labeled with your name or your dog's name.
 - Optional: You may bring your dog's bed if you think it will help him/her to be more comfortable during their stay.
